TELEPHONIC APPEARANCES BEFORE

THE 11TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT COURT.

It is the policy of the Eleventh Judicial District Court to allow telephonic appearances at hearings with certain exceptions.

Those requesting to appear by telephonic or other means shall submit the appropriate paperwork no later than 5 days prior to the court appearance. The requesting party must state in their request, the position of the opposing party.

A proposed order must be submitted at the same time as the request. Upon approval, the Court will provide a conference number and cause the order to be filed. Parties shall call in to the conference number no later than 5 minutes prior to the time of hearing. THE COURT WILL NOT CALL YOU.

The following rules and decorum shall be adhered to by all parties or the Court shall issue sanctions:

- 1. The Judge will ask all parties to identify themselves.
 - a. Each party shall state their name and how they are associated with the case, i.e. Defendant, Counsel with Plaintiff, etc.
 - b. Each party shall spell their last name for the record.

- 2. The Judge shall lead the Hearing and parties shall only speak when the Judge directs them to.
- 3. No party shall interrupt when another party is speaking.
- 4. If a party has an objection, the party shall state "objection" only. A one-word objection shall be the only form of objection allowed.
 - a. The Judge shall either direct the objecting party to expand on the objection, or, he will rule on the objection.
- 5. Should a party fail to call the number given at the appropriate date and time of the Hearing, they will be deemed a "no show" and a Show Cause shall issue for that party to appear, in person, to show cause to the Court why they did not appear by telephone at the date and time for Hearing.
- 6. Should a party request to appear by telephone and fail to appear three (3) times, they will be barred from appearing by telephone on that case.
- 7. Should a true emergency arise within 24 hours prior to the Hearing that prevent appearance by telephone, the party shall file an update/notice to the Court via the Court's e-filing system AND shall contact the Judicial Assistant regarding their inability to appear.

This order will remain in effect until further notice.
