TELEPHONIC CODE OF CONDUCT

13 It is the policy of the Eleventh Judicial District Court to allow telephonic appearances at
14 all hearings with certain exceptions.

15 Those requesting to appear by telephonic or other means shall submit the appropriate
16 paperwork no later than 5 days prior to the court appearance.

17 Upon approval by the Court, a conference call number will be provided to the party and
18 they shall call in to the Court, no later than 5 minutes prior to the time of the Hearing. THE
19 COURT WILL NOT CALL YOU.

20 The following rules and decorum shall be adhered to by all parties or the Court shall issue
21 sanctions:

- 22
- 23 1. The Judge will ask all parties to identify themselves.
 - 24 a. Each party shall state their name and how they are associated with the case, i.e.
25 Defendant, Counsel with Plaintiff, etc.
 - 26 b. Each party shall spell their last name for the record.
 - 27 2. The Judge shall lead the Hearing and parties shall only speak when the Judge directs
28 them to.

- 1 3. No party shall interrupt when another party is speaking.
- 2 4. If a party has an objection, the party shall state "objection" only. A one-word objection
- 3 shall be the only form of objection allowed.
- 4 a. The Judge shall either direct the objecting party to expand on the objection, or,
- 5 he will rule on the objection.
- 6 5. Should a party fail to call the number given at the appropriate date and time of the
- 7 Hearing, they will be deemed a "no show" and a Show Cause shall issue for that party
- 8 to appear, in person, to show cause to the Court why they did not appear by telephone
- 9 at the date and time for Hearing.
- 10 6. Should a party request to appear by telephone and fail to appear three (3) times, they
- 11 will be barred from appearing by telephone on that case.
- 12 7. Should a true emergency arise within 24 hours prior to the Hearing that prevent
- 13 appearance by telephone, the party shall file an update/notice to the Court via the
- 14 Court's e-filing system AND shall contact the Judicial Assistant regarding their
- 15 inability to appear.
- 16 8. The parties are reminded that lawyers shall be courteous, civil, and act in good faith
- 17 with all persons in court proceedings. Likewise, litigants are required to be courteous
- 18 and to treat others with respect.
