**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER (2020-02)**

14 On March 12, 2020, Governor Steve Sisolak declared a state of emergency in Nevada in  
15 response to the recent outbreak of the Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19). On March 15, 2020,  
16 Governor Sisolak ordered all public, private and charter schools closed beginning March 16,  
17 2020, in an effort to stop the spread of COVID-19.

18 The District Court is closely monitoring the developments in response to the recent  
19 outbreak of the Coronavirus disease (COVID-19). The District Court will continue to evaluate and  
20 implement measures to slow the spread of infection in our community.

21 During this time, it is critical to protect our judicial resources and prevent the spread of any  
22 illness among members of the court, counsel, staff, the public, and as well as our valuable  
23 community partners. To further prevent the spread of disease, the CDC and Prevention  
24 recommends putting distance between yourself and other people.

26 Therefore, there will be no in-person gatherings or meetings to discuss court business  
27 whatsoever, including but not limited to, all judges meetings; executive committee meetings;  
28 division judges meetings; bench-bar meetings; any meetings with community partners; specialty


1 court staffing; specialty court graduations; administrative department meetings; continuing  
2 education meetings; and meetings of any judges and/or hearing masters within a particular case  
3 assignment.

4 Necessary meetings should be conducted by telephone, teleconference, videoconference,  
5 or e-mail.

6 To the extent possible, judges should consider ways to achieve social distancing in their  
7 courtrooms and when managing their judicial departments. According to the CDC, the viral is  
8 spread mainly from people who are in close contact with one another – within approximately 6  
9 feet.

10 This Order shall be reviewed no later than every 30 days and shall continue until modified  
11 or rescinded by a subsequent Order.
